STAGE FORT PARK visit gloucester-ma.gov/450/Parks-and-Recreational-Facilities

Located at **24 Hough Avenue, Gloucester, MA**, this historic park is the site of Gloucester's first settlers in 1623 and features Half Moon & Cressy's beaches. There is a sand volleyball court, a new playground, baseball field, basketball & tennis courts. A perfect place for a picnic, there is a privately owned restaurant open to the public, a visitor center, restrooms, & many fantastic seasonal events.

A free, public access walkway along Gloucester's working waterfront & historic downtown district. Enjoy a self-guided tour with 42 granite Story Posts as well as special exhibits, events, public art, gardens, scenic views and multi-media content available right from your phone!

Tour America's oldest seaport aboard M/V Lady Jillian. The Water Shuttle connects Gloucester's two Cultural Districts, Harbortown, and Rocky Neck.

ROCKY NECK

Known for its rustic charm and eclectic works of art in a laid-back authentic setting, Rocky Neck in East Gloucester is a great place to walk around. Visit local artisans and shops or enjoy a delicious waterfront meal.

Rated as one of the top beaches in the country, this gorgeous white sand beach perfect for walking, body surfing, and volleyball. Lifeguards are on duty from Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day from 9am-5pm daily. Good Harbor Beach is one of the Carry In-Carry Out beaches in Gloucester so please carry out any trash with you when you leave. Non-resident beach parking reservations are available online.

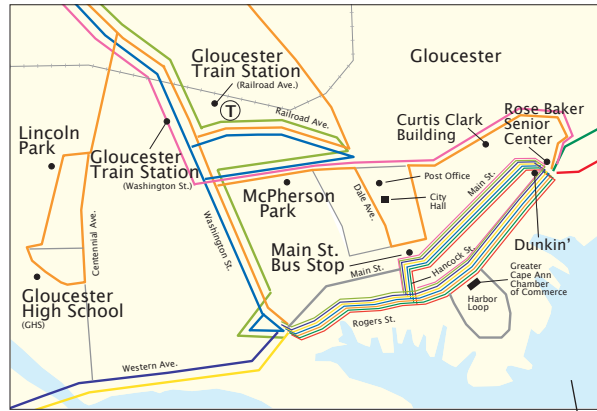
